### **REQUIREMENTS TO PARTICIPATE:**

1. The applicant must be between 18 and 35 years of age;
2. The applicant must be a New Zealand citizen, holder of a New Zealand passport or be resident of New Zealand;
3. The applicant must travel with no children;
4. The applicant must have a return air ticket or be able to prove that he or she has enough funds to cover costs for a return ticket;
5. The applicant must have medical insurance coverage while staying in Uruguay;
6. The primary intention for traveling must be holidays, with work being incidental rather than the primary reason.
